MINUTES of MEETING

Those Present – Andrew, Adrian, Bryan, Geoff, Gill, Isobel, Peter, John, Martin and Bryan, Bryan Fearn had volunteered to help on the committee and was welcomed as a newly co-opted member. Apologies – Roy and Adrian

Minutes of 14th August Meeting - These were accepted as a true record of the meeting.

Outstanding Actions - John had checked on Classic Car Show at Leighton Hall and reported that it was a show suitable for individual private entries and not really geared up to accept "club" entries.

2014 Committee - Geoff said that he planned not to stand for re-election as secretary at next year's AGM. The other existing members of the committee said that they would be prepared to continue in their roles should no other members come forward to take on the role.
