Lancaster Castle Noggin 12 March 2017

The March Noggin was attended by 17 members in 9 cars and a guest on a motorbike (the grandson of two long standing members – John and Irene). All the members arrived in their Morgans with the majority attending with their hoods down even though the weather was quite chilly at Lancaster Castle. Initially parking was somewhat tricky for those who arrived on time – the vicar's sermon was obviously an extended one. Ann was excellent at grabbing parking spaces and guiding our precious Mogs into them as members of the congregation vacated the Church car park. We did a head count and a scertained that one of our group was missing,

even though there was now ample parking. The tour of the castle was about to commence when the organiser arrived in the nick of time!!!



We had a superb tour guide who was obviously not only extremely knowledgeable but also had a passion for the history of Lancaster Castle and enthralled us with his amusing and atmospheric tone as he imparted information to us. Lancaster Castle, often known as 'John O' Gaunt's Castle' is one of the most historically fascinating surviving buildings in the country, dating back to Roman times. It is owned by The Duchy of Lancaster – Her Majesty the Queen is the Duke of Lancaster. Unfortunately we were unable to view the impressive gateway to the castle due to renovation work being carried out. However, we were able to view all aspects of the castle including the extremely impressive Civil Court with all the coats of arms of the Monarchs and the Sheriffs of Lancaster throughout their reign. The guide pointed out some shields of noble families from the area and explained the symbolism of the heraldry. The Civil Court is now often hired out for weddings, which is rather ironic as divorces proceedings were heard there in the past.



We also visited the Criminal Court which is still used on occasions today and in the dock there is the original branding iron used on criminals along with the shackle to hold the criminals hand in place whilst being branded. It is the only one left in the country and was 'demonstrated' by Vince! Lancaster Castle was originally the only Court of Justice in Lancashire, witnessing 200 executions from murder to various forms of forgery.

There has been a prison at the castle since it was originally built and debtors often outnumbered other criminals considerably. The Debtors Prison was frequently referred to as 'Hansbrow's Hotel' providing an insight regarding the conditions that existed for some inmates. How times have changed?! A prison remained on the site until 2011 and the caste is a fantastic 'living' monument to our historical past. Block 'A' provided an interesting over view of the changes in the prison over the years.

After our visit to Lancaster Castle we journeyed the short distance via the Lancaster one-way system to the Mill at Condor Green almost in convey – John and Irene nearly did not find the venue! After lunch we made our journey home with less Mog hoods down than when we arrived!
