This month's visit to Jodrell Bank (Lovell Telescope) was a great success. On a glorious day 8 Morgans arrived all with Hoods down and only one who didn't have side screens off, there were 4 other vehicles making up the group to 24 people (the maximum allowed).

Our first point of call was for a Tea/Coffee break where we were competing against lycra clad cyclists !!! The Morgan's on the car park were the outright winners.

Armed with our wrist-bands we were then allowed within the grounds and to the lecture theatre to be entertained by a 19-year-old future budding scientist who was clearly passionate about his business. Well, actually he didn't like astro-physics but he had to 'do it' as part of his Pure Maths degree, you would never have guessed from his excellent presentation. We learnt about the history of Jodrell Bank from its inception at Manchester University by Sir Bernard Lovell, his pre and post war work and the radio telescopes international role today.

In 1957 there is a suggestion that Mr Lovell was being investigated regarding mis-appropriation of public funds. He had been granted £120,000 (a lorra, lorra money in the 1950's) to build his radio telescope however delays and over budget money was not being well thought of. Fortunately, in the same year, the Russians launched Sputnik 1 to take pictures of the surface of the moon and the only instrument in the world, apart from Russia (this was the era of the cold war!) which could track it and receive signals from it was Jodrell Bank. The scientists nipped into Manchester, borrowed a fax machine form The Daily Express, ran the signals through the fax machine and printed out the pictures of the surface of the moon, probably before the Russians, and gave them to The Daily Express as a world exclusive. The rest as they say is history and Jodrell Bank's international reputation has grown ever since.

The maintenance and protection of such a large piece of engineering is also well documented. If it rains or snows the dish is merely tilted to let the moisture run off. If the dish is pointing straight up it is either receiving maintenance or it's Tuesday!

On to the more serious stuff, Black holes, exploding stars, Galaxies, radio waves, white dwarves etc, e.g. – in the 1920's Edwin Hubble and colleagues discovered that all distant galaxies are moving away from us – the universe is expanding. If we turn the clock back, the distance between galaxies shrinks and the Universe gets hotter and denser. Almost 14 billion years ago the distance shrinks to zero – this marks the beginning of the Universe, an event we call THE BIG BANG! So now you know!

After a walk around the site and arboretum to sort out fuddled minds we Morganned to The Crown Inn at Goostrey for an excellent meal and friendly banter before finally wending our way back home.
