10th Anniversary FOLKMOG Track-day 2026

Monday 7th September 2026
on the full 300 Snetterton Race Circuit.



Unbelievably 2026 will mark the 10th Anniversary of FOLKMOG running our annual Track-day which has become an important National event on the Morgan Calendar and the only track-day event entirely organized by a local centre of the MSCC. We are very proud to report that our 2025 event attracted a record entry of 40 cars with 70 drivers, additional drivers and passengers signing on. (Please see my full report in Dec 25 edition of Miscellany)

FOLKMOG have secured a booking of the fabulous 300 Snetterton Racing Circuit on Monday 7th September 2026 and certainly hope and welcome strong support from our regular entrants and any new entrants from across the whole MSCC membership, allcomers will be made very welcome.

Please come along and join our friendly group of Gentlemen and Lady drivers on our 10th Anniversary event on the fantastic 300 Snetterton Racing circuit. The main theme of the day is to have fun stretching the legs of our cherished Morgan's in a safe and relaxed format, we warmly welcome drivers of all experience, from novice first timers to experienced track-day drivers, and race car drivers.

The day comprises of the following: -

- Non-competitive event open to all MSCC members, maximum entry is 45 cars, so come along and have a go, it's great fun.
- Entrants will enjoy 7 x 20min slots on track, exclusively for our Morgan Sports Cars.
- Strictly no timing allowed, this is a non-competitive event.
- Wolf Performance will be on hand as usual, to help with any minor mechanical/technical issues.
- Entrants may bring additional drivers/passengers along, included in the entry fee.
- We encourage and warmly welcome spectators to watch our Morgan cars on circuit and will be delighted to see as many old friends and new as possible back this September, entry is free and there's plenty of Track- action from 09.00hrs to 17.00hrs.
- We are always superbly supported by our local Morgan Dealer, Krazy Horse, who have supported this event from day 1, they always bring the latest models and several Morgan's along for MSCC members to test drive by arrangement.

We strongly recommend all entrants to speak to their insurers to advise them you will be taking part in a non-competitive track-day event. MSCC recommended Insurer's are normally happy to insure you for the day f.o.c. but some may require an excess for the day based on the value of your Morgan. Entrants should advise their insurers in good time for the event.

The day is usually shared with the MG Owners Club, and last year with the Caterham and Lotus 7 Club pf GB, who also enjoy exclusive sessions on track, so there's plenty of action on track throughout the day.

What does the day Look like?

The day begins early with signing on, followed by a briefing by MSV's Clerk of the Course to explain the rules for the on-track activity. Our cars will need noise testing,

then the first session on circuit is behind the MSV Course Car to show us the braking and turn in points around the circuit.

MSV will provide professional management, with medics and safety marshals for all on-track activity. Our exclusive Morgan sessions are for 20mins each hour, with a 1-hour lunch break, our first session is usually at 09.40hrs.

Entrants, additional drivers and passengers will need to bring your own full-face helmets (unless you have a hard top when open face helmets are allowed) MSV have helmets available to hire on the day at a modest cost. You must have your arms and legs covered (no bare skin allowed on track!!) gloves are optional but are a good idea.

The main aim is to provide a safe and controlled "on-track" environment, so drivers can explore the performance of their Morgan Sports Cars and most importantly have some fun.

We had a superb day at last year's event, with perfect weather. We look forward to another fabulous day on Monday 7th September 2026, so make this a firm date in your diary.

FOLKMOG will provide full joining instructions and protocol documents well in advance of the event.

We anticipate the estimated cost for the day will be approx. £230 per car entered, which will include the cost of additional drivers/passengers, bearing in mind we still await final costing for the track-hire from the track-owners Motor Sport Vision.

We wish to attract a full entry of up to 45 cars at our Anniversary event, and once we have a good number of entrants registered we will be in touch with payment details, collection of fees will start in May 2026.
